1. All chairs, crates, equipment must remain within designated area.
2. Paper and/or plastic must be used under all pens. No shavings will be available at the show site.
3. Crates of dogs left in the buildings overnight must be clearly labeled with contact information of person responsible for the dogs.
4. Exhibit halls will open at 6:00 AM on Thursday, Friday, Saturday, and Sunday, and close at 11:00 PM on Thursday, Friday and Saturday. Grooming areas must be cleared one hour after Best in Show on Sunday. Halls will open at 8:00 AM on Wednesday and close at 11:00 PM.

PARKING INFORMATION

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS REGARDING CORRECTION OR CHANGES TO ENTRIES: The specific changes listed in Ch. 11, Sec. 6 (i.e. sex of a dog, transfers between age specific regular classes and "move-ups" to BOB or BOV) of the Dog Show Rules are the *only* changes to the entries superintendents or secretaries are authorized to make *after closing of entries*. **THIS RULE IS STRICTLY ENFORCED BY THE AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB. PLEASE CHECK YOUR ENTRIES CAREFULLY.** Corrections to entries may be made by the Superintendent prior to the closing of entries if such correction is submitted in writing. Exhibitors are required to report any changes/corrections after closing directly to the American Kennel Club.

The Bred-by-Exhibitor Class shall be for dogs that are:

- a) Six months of age or older as of the first day of the show;
 - b) Not Champions of record on the date of closing of entries for the show;
 - c) Individually registered with the American Kennel Club as of the date of closing of entries for the show;
 - d) Owned or co-owned by any of the breeders of record as of the date of the closing of entries for the show.
- The person handling the dog in this class must be a breeder of record and an owner of record of this dog. In any subsequent classes for which the dog from the Bred-by-Exhibitor class becomes eligible, there are no restrictions as to who may handle.*

BEST OF BREED (VARIETY) COMPETITION

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

Winners of these classes if not defeated in another class, are eligible to compete in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition.

Because competitive classes beyond Best of Breed (Variety) are offered at this show, entries in this class may NOT be spayed or neutered and must meet their individual breed standard requirements.

Veteran Dog Class - For dogs seven (7) years of age and over.

Veteran Bitch Class - For bitches seven (7) years of age and over.

THE FOLLOWING NON-REGULAR SINGLE DOG CLASS IS OPEN ONLY TO CAIRN TERRIERS

Working Dog Class Working Bitch Class

Open to all Cairn Terriers, six months of age or older, who have earned an Earthdog title. Entrants may NOT be spayed or neutered. Winners of these classes, if not defeated in another class, are eligible to compete in Best of Breed Competition.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

THE FOLLOWING NON-REGULAR MULTIPLE DOG CLASSES ARE OPEN ONLY TO CAIRN TERRIERS

***Stud Dog Class.** For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes or if a Champion of Record in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition, but MUST be entered in the Stud Dog Class. The Get MUST be entered in one of the regular classes or Best of Breed Competition. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee, this being the regular fee plus the additional class fee if the Stud Dog is entered in another class. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get.

***Brood Bitch Class.** Same as for the Stud Dog Class, except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

**Chapter 11, Section 8: of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."*

Brace Class: For two Cairn Terriers (a unit), irrespective of sex, with at least one common owner and shown in the ring with no more than two handlers. Dogs may be entered in another class or for brace class only. The dogs comprising the brace must be named at the time of entry. Full particulars must be given for each dog on an individual entry form. If a dog that is to be part of a brace is entered in another class and entered as part of a brace, specify "Brace Class" in the Additional Classes section of the form. If a dog is not entered in another class, specify "Brace Class Only" in the Dog Show Class section of the form.

Champions may NOT be entered in this sweepstakes. Entries in the Sweepstakes may be shown by anyone in good standing with the American Kennel Club except Professional Handlers, anyone in their employ and their families, unless the dog is owned by them. 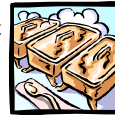
