

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures, or the "Agreement" that accompanies the Official AKC Entry form.
- Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to the close of entries. Changes received by telephone are not accepted.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. Entries accompanied by returned checks will be charged an additional \$25 fee.
- No smoking or alcohol permitted on school grounds.
- Exhibitors are responsible to pick up after their dog – no exceptions!
- Exhibitors are required to clean up their grooming area following the show.
- Dogs allowed in rings during judging only.
- There shall be no drilling or intensive or abusive training of dogs on the match grounds.
- Columbia River Cairn Terrier Club, its officers and members assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property or children.

Junior Showmanship: participants must be at least 8 years of age and no more than 18 years of age on the date of the Match

Junior Showmanship

- **Novice Class:** For boys and girls who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.
- **Open Class:** For boys and girls who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.
- **Novice and Open Classes Divided:** Junior - 8 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show; Intermediate - 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show. Senior - 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, (919) 816-3776. Be sure all information for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

RIBBONS

Ribbons will be awarded to the first, second, third, and fourth place in each class as follows: 1st – rose, 2nd – brown, 3rd – light green, 4th – gray. Rosettes will be awarded as follows: Best of Breed – orange, Best of Opposite to Best of Breed – lavender, Best Junior – green with pink edges. Participants with a qualifying score in all obedience classes – green with pink edges. High in Match – green with pink edges.

TROPHIES

Best of Breed – a green crystal bowl and framed win picture. Best of Opposite to Best of Breed – a dog first aid kit and framed win picture. Best Junior – a canvas grooming bag and framed win picture. High in Match – a ceramic treat jar and framed win picture.

PRIZES

1st place in all conformation classes will receive a treat jar. 1st place in all obedience classes will receive a flexi-lead. A toy of less than \$5 value will be given to all 2nd through 4th class placements in conformation and obedience.
