DRIVING DIRECTIONS:

I-5 TOWARDS AURORA:

11: Take the exit, exit number 278, towards AURORA NAT'L HISTORIC DIST./DONALD.	0.2 miles 0.4 (km)
12: Turn WEST onto EHLEN RD NE.	2.6 miles 4.2 (km)
13: Turn SLIGHT RIGHT onto YERGEN RD NE.	1.0 miles 1.5 (km)
14: Turn RIGHT onto CASE RD NE.	1.3 miles 2.2 (km)
15: Turn SLIGHT LEFT onto CHAMPOEG RD NE.	0.9 miles 1.5 (km)
16: You're in the vicinity of the state park. Look for the state park shield or name on a sign along the roadway.	

Please help make camping here a safe and enjoyable experience by following these and other park rules:

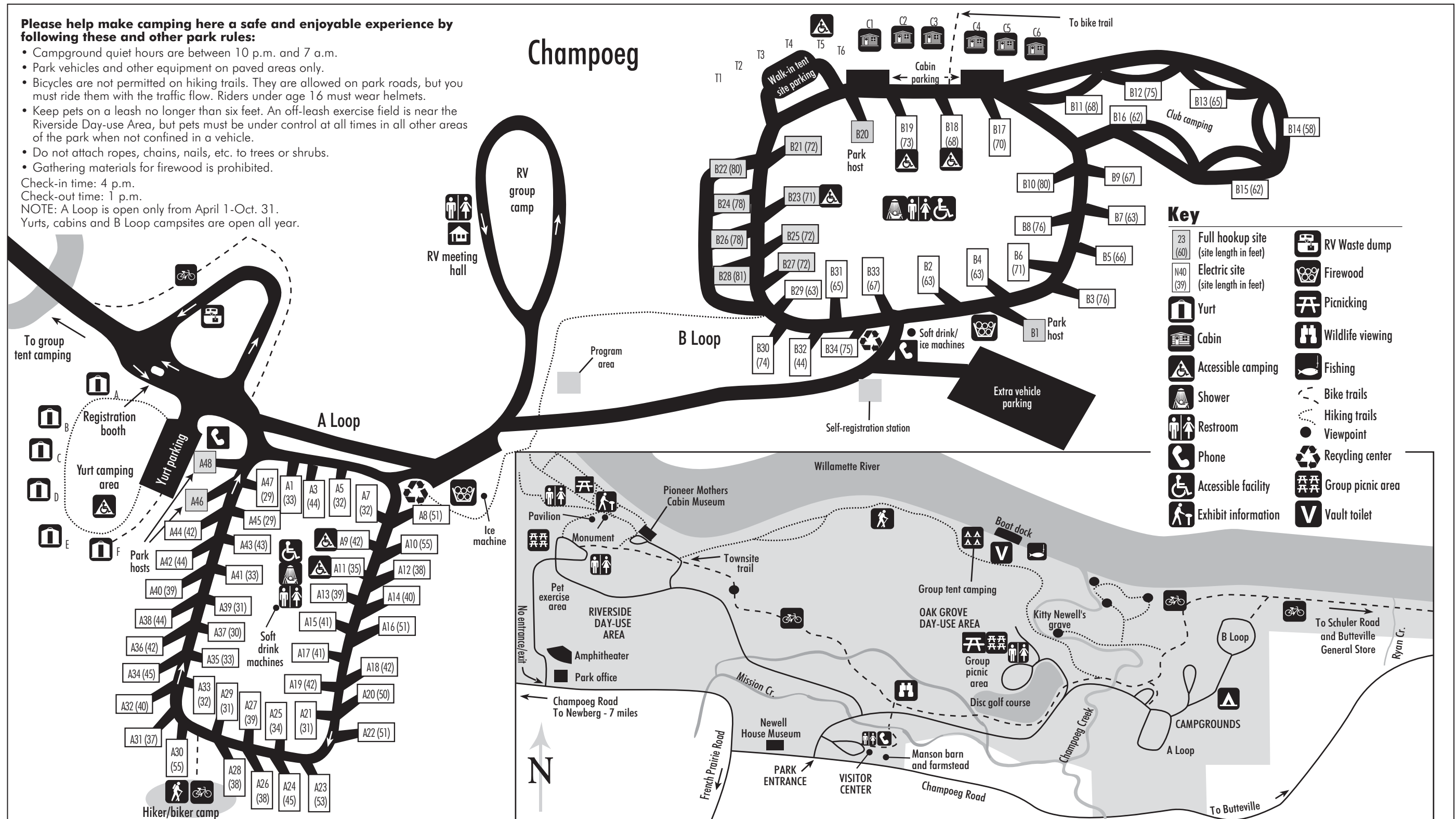
- Campground quiet hours are between 10 p.m. and 7 a.m.
- Park vehicles and other equipment on paved areas only.
- Bicycles are not permitted on hiking trails. They are allowed on park roads, but you must ride them with the traffic flow. Riders under age 16 must wear helmets.
- Keep pets on a leash no longer than six feet. An off-leash exercise field is near the Riverside Day-use Area, but pets must be under control at all times in all other areas of the park when not confined in a vehicle.
- Do not attach ropes, chains, nails, etc. to trees or shrubs.
- Gathering materials for firewood is prohibited.

Check-in time: 4 p.m.

Check-out time: 1 p.m.

NOTE: A Loop is open only from April 1-Oct. 31.

Yurts, cabins and B Loop campsites are open all year.
